CRISTIAN MARTÍN

With a degree from the Royal Professional Dance Conservatory in Madrid and a member of the Academy of Scenic Arts of Spain, this seasoned dancer and young creator is one of the most profiled talents on the emerging national scene. His training and versatile dance is ample and heterogeneous, spanning from training in classical ballet to Spanish dance and flamenco, the arts of movement, and even contemporary creations.

His career path as a dancer started under the auspices of the maestro Granero, and as a soloist he has formed part of the most relevant companies in the country.

He is a regular guest performer for the dance companies Teresa Nieto and Manuel Liñán and has since the year 2009 been a recurring collaborator, prompter and guest artist at the Daniel Doña Dance Company.

In 2015 he won the first price for his solo choreography at the Spanish Dance and Flamenco Choreography Contest in Madrid for his piece *MATERIA* [*Matter*]. This became the start of his path as a choreographer and he soon thereafter created his own *Company Proyecto Lanza* [*Spear Project*], where he has staged a variety of different performances.

Amongst those is *S E R* [*To Be*] premiering at the 2018 International Dance Festival in Madrid. With this performance he has toured both national and international festivals such as the Auditorium Parco Della Música di Roma. *MÁRGENES* [*Margins*], his company's second production, has premiered at the Canal Theatres in Madrid.

Apart from his work as a guest maestro for different national conservatories, his activity as lecturer and creator has also taken him beyond the national borders, such as to the University of New Mexico, in the USA.

SANDRA CARRASCO

Born in Huelva, Andalusia in 1981, she spent the early days of her professional career singing for prominent characters such as Arcángel, El Pele, Manolo Sanlúcar, Miguel Poveda, Estrella Morente, et al.

Settling in Madrid in 2007, she has formed part of the musical *Enamorados Anónimos* [*Anonymous Lovers*] created by José María Cámara and Javier Limón together with Blanca Li.

With Javier Limón she recorded her first album, *Sandra Carrasco*. Others were soon to follow, such as *Océano [Ocean]*, *Travesía [Journey]*, *La luz del entendimiento [The Light of Understanding*] and the upcoming *El Belingonero Flamenco* [The Belingonero Flamenco]. She has worked with musicians such as Anoushka Shankar, Avishai Cohen, Javier Colina, Jerry González, Richard Bona, Josemi Carmona, and many others.

She is the lead voice in the Greek tragedy *Electra*, directed by the choreographer and dancer Antonio Ruz for the National Ballet of Spain. With Ruz she had previously shared the stage, as part of her work for Estévez/Paños and Company.



DANIEL DOÑA

Daniel Doña is one of the most outstanding dancers, choreographers, and creators in the current panorama of Spanish dance. His work transcends formal lines, capturing the essence of various styles and references. He moves comfortably between renewed Spanish dance, flamenco, and contemporary dance without keeping to one particular style. Running his own dance company since 2013, Daniel Doña continuously attracts new spectators to his performances characterised by merging tradition and innovation.
